Artefact type: polished chisel

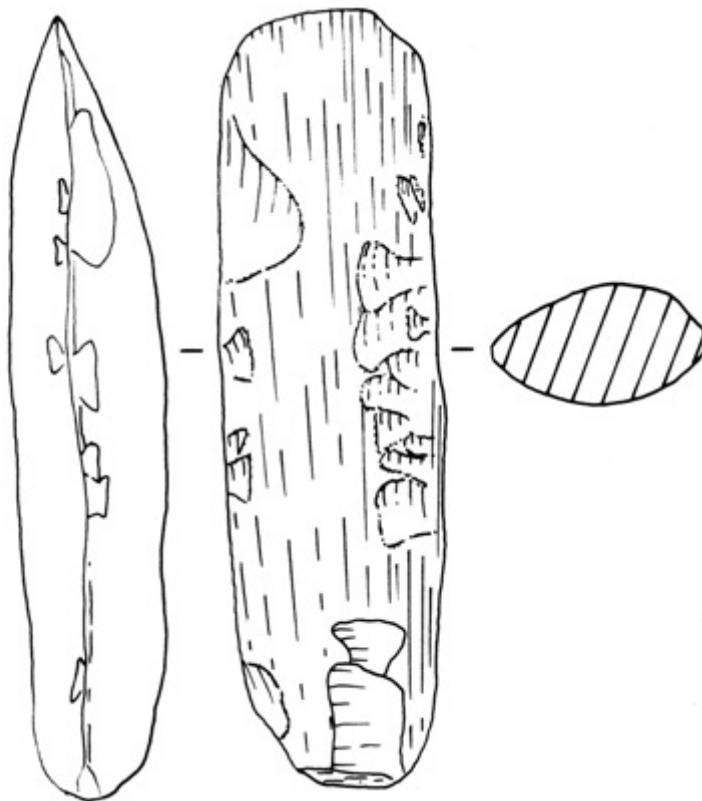
Raw material: FMs1 (provenance: probably Mons region – *Spiennes*)

Length: 101 mm

Maximum width: 29 mm (medial part = distal part = proximal part)

Maximum thickness: 19 mm (medial part)

Weight: 75 g

Means of artefact collection: fieldwalking

Artefact type: polished axe

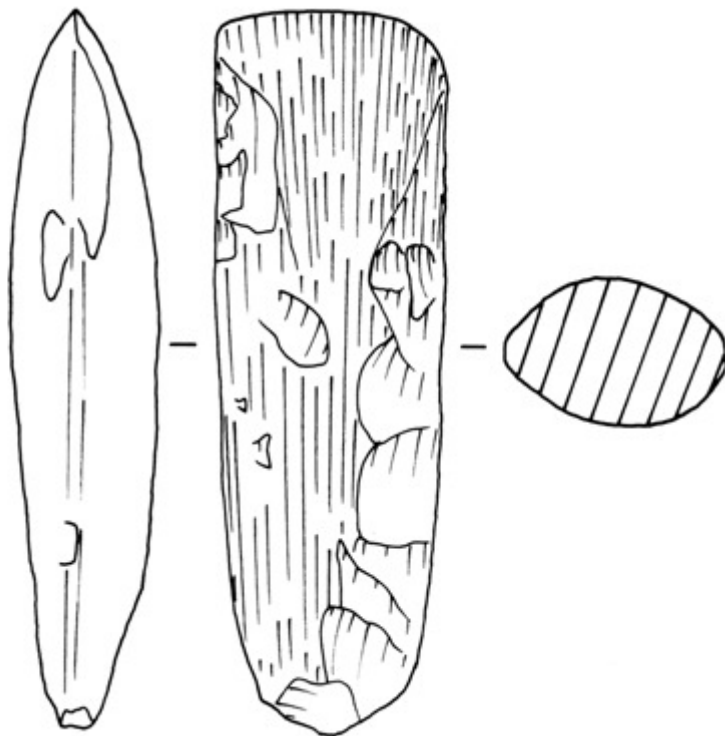
Raw material: ISs1 (provenance: probably Mons region – *Spiennes*)

Length: 94 mm

Maximum width: 30 mm (distal part > medial part > proximal part)

Maximum thickness: 19 mm (medial part)

Weight: 72 g



Silly-Rue Wastinne (province of Hainaut)

Lambert-coordinates: X118081 / Y150216 (ploughed farmland)

Means of artefact collection: fieldwalking

Artefact type: polished axe

Raw material: SWs1 (provenance: probably Mons region – *Spiennes*)

Length: 107 mm (damaged cutting-edge)

Maximum width: 43 mm (distal part > medial part > proximal part)

Maximum thickness: 22 mm

Weight: 137 g
